

RAZPRAVE – ČLANKI

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Knjižnice in bralci s posebnimi potrebami

Prispevek obravnava dostopnost gradiva za bralce s posebnimi potrebami, zlasti se osredotoča na bralno ovirane osebe. Pri tem upošteva dosegljivost prostora, opreme in informacij ter različne prilagoditve knjižnih gradiv. Navaja nekaj primerov, kako so posamezne splošne knjižnice v Sloveniji poskrbele za svoje bralce s težavami branja in se povezale z institucijami v svojem okolju. Opozarja tudi na terminologijo in razvoj nove vrste pismenosti.

The article discusses the accessibility of materials for readers with special needs, focusing specifically on persons with reading disabilities, and taking into account accessibility of space, equipment and information, as well as different adaptations of reading materials. It further states examples of public libraries in Slovenia which provided for their visitors with reading disabilities by seeking connections with institutions in their local environment. The article also points out terminology problems and the creation of a new kind of literacy.
